

## Minute 2

### Call no. CCMAR/TSIM/06/2024

#### I - Introduction

On the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June two thousand and twenty-four, at 10 hours, the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 02-05-2024, met by videoconference, for the meeting 2 of the call Ref. CCMAR/TSIM/06/2024. The meeting was held for the award of a position for a Research Diving Officer (Técnico/a Superior de Investigação e Mergulho) (M/F), in the scientific field of biology and scientific diving to satisfy temporary needs under an uncertain term employment contract in order to support the work carried in the context of the PROTOCOLO DE COLABORAÇÃO TÉCNICA E FINANCEIRA - Avaliação e implementação de conservação ecossistémica de cavalos-marinhos funded by Fundo Ambiental, other projects and connected activities. The nominated jury present at the meeting was composed by Professor Diogo Paulo, auxiliary researcher at CCMAR, Professor at Algarve University; and Coordinator of the CCMAR diving centre (president of the jury); Professor Jorge Gonçalves, principal researcher with aggregation at CCMAR, Professor at Algarve University (full member) and Doctor Bárbara Horta e Costa, auxiliary researcher at CCMAR and Algarve University (full member) with the following agenda: admission and evaluation of applications admitted to the position CCMAR/TSIM/06/2024.

#### II – Candidates

One application was received for the position of Research Diving Officer:

#### III – Admission and Evaluation of applications

The candidate was admitted to the evaluation and ranking phase (Table 2). The Jury evaluated the application documents of the eligible candidates, and applied the classification criteria and the respective weightings set out in the notice of opening of the call, as shown in table 2 below:

#### Criteria:

1. Experience in gas blending (10%);
2. Experience as skipper with a boat's license (carta de patrão local) (20%);
3. Experience in scientific diving (60%);
4. Experience as a diving instructor (10%).

#### V - Conclusion

The candidate obtained a final classification of 85 points (Table 2), and is ranked first (85 points; Table 3).


Considering the elements presented, the candidate Guilherme Contente Rosado gathers conditions for the purposes of eventual selection, so the jury proposes the ratification of this decision to the CCMAR Board.

The Jury will proceed to the right of prior hearing of the candidates, setting a deadline of 10 working days to claim what they consider to be convenient, whether in relation to scientific or procedural matters.

We further declare that we have no direct or indirect financial, economic or personal interest that could compromise our impartiality and autonomy as members of this Jury.


Thus, we declare under word of honor that we will not evaluate candidates with whom we have a conflict of interest, for what we will require our immediate replacement.
