

Minute 2

On the 06th day of August two thousand and twenty-four at 09 hours the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 23-05-2024, met by videoconference, for the meeting 2 of the call Ref. CCMAR/IA/07/2024. The meeting was held for the award of a vacancy for an assistant researcher (M/F) in the field of Chemical Oceanography under an uncertain term working contract for applicants of any nationality. This position is open to citizens of any nationality, including stateless individuals, under an unfixed-term employment contract to recruit and select the best candidate for activities within the Institutional CEEC - Support Contract for Associated Laboratories funded by the Foundation for Science and Technology (FCT).

The nominated jury is composed of Adelino Canário, President of the CCMAR Board of Directors and Full Professor at the University of Algarve (President); Fátima Filomena Guedes Abrantes, Coordinating Researcher at IPMA and CCMAR (regular member); Paulo Relvas, Assistant Professor at the University of Algarve and researcher at CCMAR (regular member); Alice Newton, Associated Professor at the University of Algarve (regular member) and Maria Eduarda da Cunha Pereira, Associate Professor at the University of Aveiro (regular member);

The agenda item was the extension of the deadline of applications for the call CCMAR/IA/07/2024. The Jury has decided to extend the application deadline for the position of assistant researcher (M/F) in the field of Chemical Oceanography. This extension allows for greater convenience in scheduling jury meetings and ensures procedural efficiency by maximising the effectiveness of the current call.

All current applicants will be notified of this extension and will have the option to update or maintain their applications.

The jury of the call fully understands the confidential nature of the assessment process and agrees not to disclose or discuss its materials, nowhere, with no one knowing the consequences of misconduct. The jury further declares that it does not have any direct or indirect financial, economic or personal interest that could compromise our impartiality and autonomy as members of this Jury. Thus, the jury declares under the word of honour that it will not evaluate candidates with whom they have a conflict of interest, for which the jury will require their immediate replacement.
