#### I - Introduction

On the 14<sup>th</sup> day of the month of October, two thousand and twenty-four, at 17 hours, the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 07-08-2024, met by videoconference, for the second meeting of the call Ref. CCMAR/TM/32/2024. The meeting was held for the award of a position for a Multimedia Technician (Técnico/a de Multimédia) (M/F), to satisfy temporary needs under an uncertain term employment contract. The nominated jury was composed by Doctor Rita Abecasis, head of the CCMAR Science Communication Unit (president of the jury), Professor Adelino Canário, Professor at Algarve University, researcher and president of the board of Directors at CCMAR (member), and Dr. Anaís Guerra, Communication Officer at the CCMAR Science Communication Unit (member) with the following agenda: evaluation of the applications admitted to the position CCMAR/TM/32/2024.

#### II - Statement of no conflict of interests

#### III –Evaluation of applications

Between 7<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> of October the jury contacted candidates Inês Correia de Sousa Pascoal, Rafael Imperatriz, Luís Miguel Botelho da Purificação, Vânia Martins to clarify curricular aspects.

The jury then evaluated the application documents of the eligible candidates and applied the classification criteria and the respective weightings set out in the notice of opening of the call, as shown in table 1, indicating the final score and ranking of candidates admitted to the call.

Criteria:

1. Experience and skills (30%)
2. Portfolio (40%)
3. Motivation letter (10%)
4. Qualifications (20%)

Considering the elements presented, the candidate **Inês Correia de Sousa Pascoal** gathers conditions for the purposes of eventual selection so the jury proposes the ratification of this decision to the CCMAR Board.

The Jury will proceed to the right of prior hearing of all the candidates, setting a deadline of 10 working days to claim what they consider to be convenient, whether in relation to scientific or procedural matters.

With no other item on the agenda, the meeting of which these minutes were drawn up was closed, with 3 pages, which after being read and approved were signed by the members of the jury.
