

## **CCMAR Biobank**

### **Terms of use**

By accessing material from the CCMAR Biobank, including but not limited to all biological material, data, documents, and website content, the User accept and agree to be bound by the following Terms of Use:

#### Intellectual Property:

All CCMAR Biobank Material acquired by the User, including but not limited to biological material, original data, text, images, audio, video, data, software, content presented in multimedia formats is the intellectual property of CCMAR Biobank. CCMAR Biobank retains all rights, including copyrights to the Material. In cases where data and other content provided by CCMAR Biobank are not protectable by copyright, access to such materials is still conditioned upon the User's acceptance of these Terms of Use, including the restrictions on use specified below. To the extent data and other content made available to the User by the CCMAR Biobank is not protectable by copyright, the User access to said Material is conditioned upon the User acceptance of the terms of this User Agreement, including the use restrictions set forth below.

#### Confidentiality

The User agrees to maintain the confidentiality of any non-public materials or data provided by CCMAR Biobank and to use such confidential information solely for the purposes permitted under these Terms of Use. The User shall not disclose such confidential information to any third party without the prior written consent of CCMAR Biobank.

#### Limited General License:

CCMAR Biobank Users agree that all Materials that are provided by the CCMAR Biobank fall under the CCMAR Biobank sole control and ownership. The User will not reproduce, sell, lend, distribute, display, perform, or engage in any other use of the Material. Copying or redistributing CCMAR Biobank Material in any manner for commercial use, including commercial publication, or for personal gain, is strictly prohibited without specific written consent. CCMAR Biobank reserves the right to revoke the license to use its materials if these terms are violated.

The User agrees to cite the CCMAR Biobank Material ID number(s) in all disclosures, publications and patent applications that reference the Material and acknowledge the CCMAR Biobank as the source of the Material. For Material obtained from CCMAR Biobank, the User shall additionally reference the website's URL. For content obtained from CCMAR Biobank Arctos database, the User shall



additionally reference the database URL. The User is kindly requested to provide the CCMAR Biobank with details of the related publications.

This agreement applies to CCMAR Biobank Content obtained from Arctos as well as from secondary biodiversity information sources (e.g., OBIS, GBIF, GGBN, EMBRC-TRACE). CCMAR Biobank records obtained from such sources are suitable for data discovery, but should be verified against the CCMAR Biobank database, which will include the most up-to-date information.

#### Use of Third-Party Content:
